



Don Meredith's Position on Carry Concealed Weapon Permits

As Sheriff of Los Angeles County, my guidelines for the issuance of the CCW (Carry Concealed Weapon) permit will be much the same as the Orange County guidelines:

- The applicant/permit holder **must be a legal resident of the County.**
- The applicant must provide **proof of proficiency in gun safety, the law, and the ability to handle the weapon safely.** This will require successful completion of an approved or sponsored course of the Department that includes civil liability, criminal liability, tactical considerations (to include not creating a situation where a peace officer other CCW holder mistakes the applicant for a suspect), firearm safety and qualification at an approved range.
- The applicant must be a **responsible member of the community**, with **no prior convictions, mental illness, or history of disturbances within the community.**
- The applicant must **establish good cause for the permit**, including but not limited to a high-risk occupation in a dangerous environment.
- **Each application will be considered independently.** It is not possible to provide specific guidelines as each application will be considered totally on the weight of its own merits.
